


V. The Lord be with you. R. And with your spir-it.




V. Lift up your hearts. R. We lift them up to the Lord.




V. Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. R. It is right and just.






you are one God, one Lord: not in the unity of a sin-gle per-son,




but in a Trini - ty of one sub-stance. For what you have revealed
