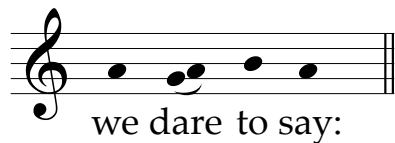
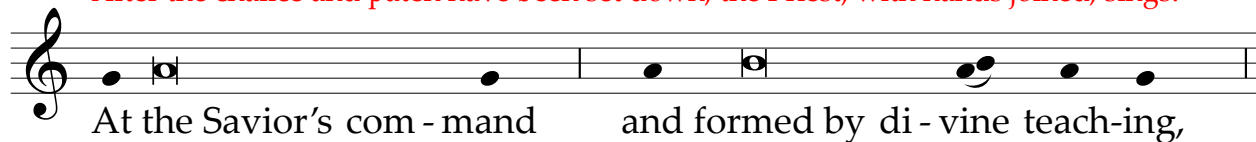


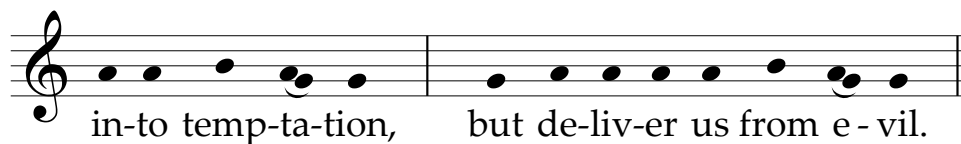
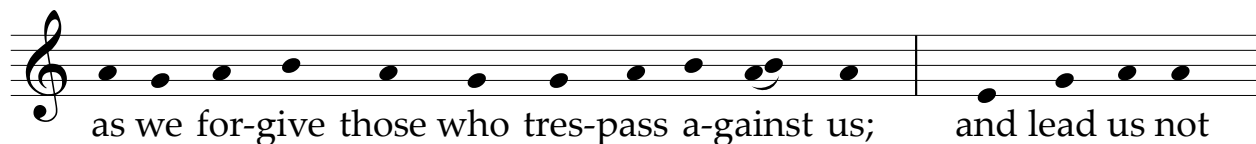
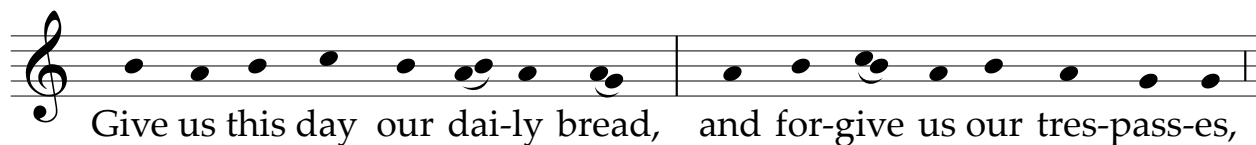
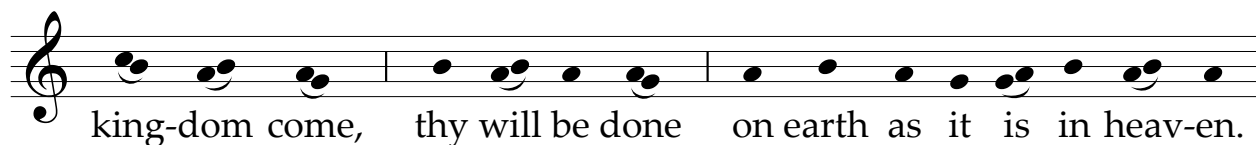
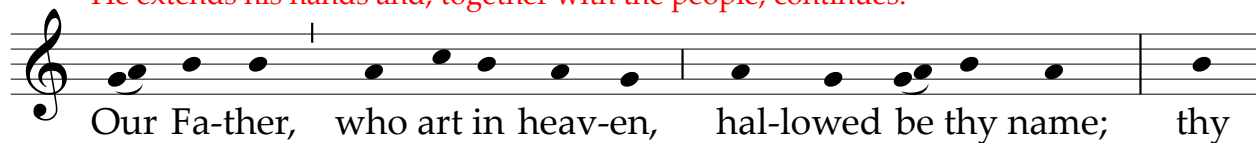
The Communion Rite

Lord's Prayer, Embolism, and Doxology

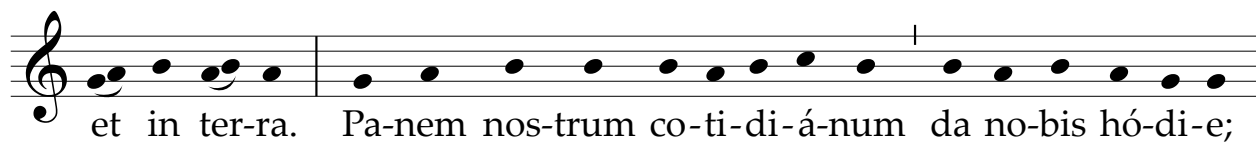
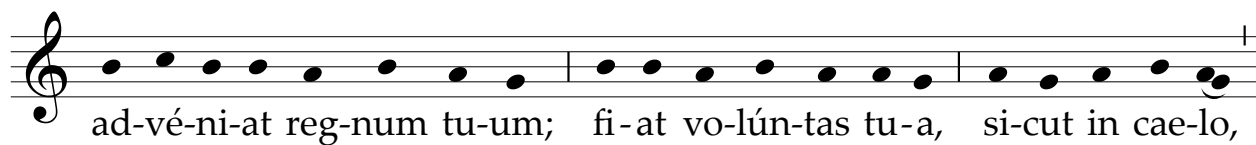
After the chalice and paten have been set down, the Priest, with hands joined, sings:



He extends his hands and, together with the people, continues:

 and the coming of our Sav-ior, Je-sus Christ.

He joins his hands.

The people conclude the prayer, acclaiming:

For the king-dom, the power and the glo-ry are yours now and for
 ev-er.
